**JUN 6, 2018: LONDON** This morning, learn about London's majestic past and fast-paced present on your guided sightseeing tour. See busy Trafalgar Square and the Houses of Parliament as well as the more modern landmarks like the Gherkin, the Shard, and the Cheese Grater—all new buildings changing the London skyline. This afternoon awaken your inner thespian during a theatre workshop in London's famed West End! Tonight, have dinner together at a local restaurant and then see a production of a West End Musical! (B,D)

**JUN 7, 2018: LONDON** Get your imagination fired up for today's visit to Oxford, including a tour of Christchurch College where Lewis Carroll penned *Alice's Adventures in Wonderland* and also where many memorable scenes from the *Harry Potter* movies were filmed (note the Great Hall, the inspiration for Hogwarts Hall). Then continue to Stratford-upon-Avon to visit Shakespeare's Birthplace and his burial site at Holy Trinity Church. After a pre-theater dinner, experience a performance by the world-renowned Royal Shakespeare Company (in the event that it is unavailable, a play in London's West End will be substituted). We return to London in the evening. (B,D)

**JUN 8, 2018: LONDON** All the world may be a stage, but to get an authentic feel of Shakespeare's theater it is essential to visit the reconstructed Globe Theatre along the Thames Embankment. Attend a workshop at The Globe, conducted by actors, that introduces you to both the plays of Shakespeare and the conditions in which Elizabethan actors worked. This afternoon, enjoy time to explore London at your own pace, before rejoining your group for dinner together. Tonight, see a production at the Globe Theatre (in the event that a Globe Theatre performance is unavailable, a play in London's West End will be substituted) (B,D)

**JUN 9, 2018: LONDON** This morning, visit the Royal Academy of Dramatic Art for a backstage tour. Get a behind the scenes look at the Academy's current site and an opportunity to find out more about the Academy's history: from the humble beginnings in the dome of 'His Majesty's Theatre', to its present day residence. Have time for lunch on your own. Then further learn about London's theatre scene during a National Theatre backstage tour. Your entertaining guide will share performance secrets and provide an insider's look at all the contributing pieces to a thriving and active production facility. The rest of your evening is yours to enjoy dinner on your own. (B)

**JUN 10, 2018: LONDON** This morning, we will attend services at a local catholic church. Afterwards, journey out to Windsor Castle, the official residence of the British reigning monarch, Queen Elizabeth II, where you will learn all about England's Royal Family. On returning to London, enjoy soem time exploring at your own pace, perhaps doing some last-minute souvenir shopping! Rejoin your group tonight for a special farewell dinner together. (B,D)
